Overview

Kamay Botany Bay National Park is located on the southern side of Botany Bay. Aboriginal people lived at this site for thousands of years. In 1770 the local Aboriginal people meet with James Cook and the crew of the Endeavour. The bay was named by Cook and Sir Joseph Banks because of the interesting flora on it's shores. The bay is now an important cargo port.

Primary and Secondary programs include:

- Acknowledgement to Country
- Aboriginal histories and cultures
- Guided bushwalk
- Explore the beach shoreline and rock platform
- Individual programs can be catered for
